

This land is owned by a private nonprofit organization comprised of Nez Perce members and other local and regional supporters. As part of our mission we maintain this property as a place for Nez Perce use. Tribal members and tribal events are always granted priority use of these grounds.

Overnight Camping Policy:

All campers must check-in before camping by filling out our Camp Registration Form. These forms are available at the Homeland office located at 209 E. 2nd Street in Wallowa. Call 541-886-3101 with questions.

Payment for camping is due at the time of registration: \$10/night OR \$50/week and \$5/day extra for electrical. **Camping for tribal members is free**, **donations are always welcome.**

No camping in or near the Dance Arbor or the Aspen Grove (around the purple bench). There is one designated RV site for electricity to the north of the bathroom. All other campers please disperse camping well away from the Dance Arbor and within 20 feet of the road. Keep vehicles away from the hillside due to falling rocks. Please contact the office for use of the horse corrals.

2-week maximum stay length. Exceptions made for tribal members on a case by case basis.

Rules for Camping:

- Use this facility at your own risk.
- Respect the land as important to the Nez Perce.
- Use of alcohol and drugs is prohibited.
- Put campfires dead out and follow posted restrictions.
- Keep the camping areas & restrooms clean. Take all trash with you when you leave.
- Keep dogs under control & clean up after them.
- No firearms, hunting, or trapping allowed on the property.
- No use of ATVs or dirt bikes off the main roads. Adhere to 5 mph speed limit.

These rules apply to all campers and visitors to the Homeland grounds. NO EXCEPTIONS. Anyone unable to follow these rules will be asked to leave the grounds.
